Ripe aromas of red raspberries, crushed blackberries, and a hint of spice. The palate is balanced with dark fruit, tarragon, and chalky minerality. A gently grippy and fresh finish.

Varieties: 100% Pinot Noir

Soil: Deep red clay and limestone

Elevation: 250 meters

Age of Vines: Planted in 1962

Yield: 40hl/hectare

Farming Practices: Organic and biodynamic

Fermentation: 100% destemmed with indigenous yeasts in cement tanks

Aging: 11 to 12 months on lees in 15% new oak barrels

Production: 250 cases per year
