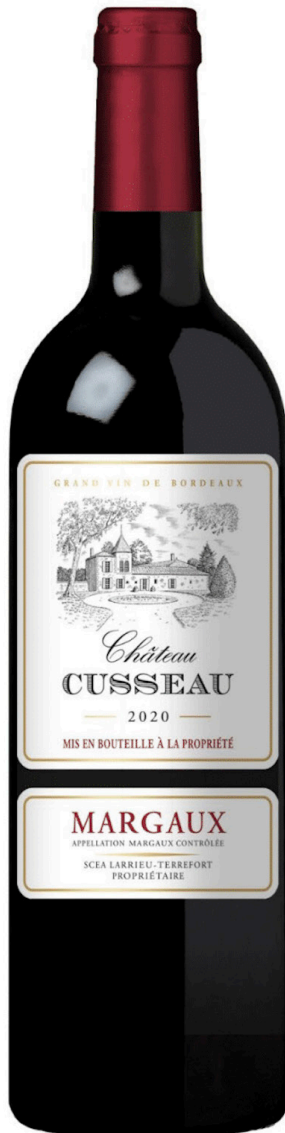


CHATEAU CUSSEAU

Style: Still Red

Area of Production: Bordeaux, France

Appellation: Margaux

Varieties: 60% Cabernet Sauvignon; 40% Merlot

Soil: Gravel over sand and pebbles

Fermentation vessel: In stainless steel vats

Aging: 10 months in 30% new French oak barrels
