Elegant with notes of bright cherry, wild violets, and button mushroom. The palate is medium bodied and structured with integrated tannins and notes of cinnamon, anise, and tobacco.

Color: Red

Area of Production: Burgundy, France

Appellation: Nuits-Saint-Georges

Varietals: Pinot Noir

Elevation: About 300 meters

Soil: Marl and limestone, with pebbles from the Meuzin Valley

Age of Vines: 50 years

Fermentation: In stainless steel tanks with native yeasts

Aging: 12 to 14 months in 20% new French oak barrels
