Fragrant aromas of red berries, fresh citrus, crushed herbs, and a hint of cocoa. Crisp and refreshing on the palate with flavors of dark fruit and white pepper spice. Firm tannins are balanced by bright acidity.

Style: Still red

Area of Production: Sicily, Italy

Appellation: Etna Rosso DOC

Vineyard: Passopisciaro

Varieties: Nerello Mascalese, Nerello Cappuccio, Alicante, and Francis

Soil: Volcanic ash and sand

Elevation: 850 meters

Age of Vines: 100 years on average

Farming: Practicing organic

Fermentation: In open oak vats with native yeasts

Ageing: 24 months in stainless steel followed by 6 months in bottle
